


Changing the name of your monitored points can be done from the dashboard. Once logged in, click on the Data tab on the top left menu, and finally on the Attributes icon on the top right corner.



Follow the steps below to update the name of your monitored points. The process is illustrated with the “Boogle Data Center” site where the point named “Hall 1” is changed to “Chillers”.

1. The first step is to select the point you are interested in in the menu tree (i.e. Hall 1 under Boogle Data Center). Current data point information is displayed.
2. Click on the double pencil symbol at the top right to edit the name.




